Why do we do what we do?

We have often seen two people in the same situation behave differently sometimes. For e.g., when a building is on fire, we can see one person saving his own life while the other person putting his own life at risk and rescuing others. All though there are many factors responsible for human behaviour like age, health, family background etc, "values" are emerging as the most important of these. The beliefs that the person holds true even in an adverse situation form his values. Human values are called as the "compass" that guide people's behaviour. (Shwartz, 1992)

Values basically guide our preferences and help us choose our course of action in a given situation. Values come from various sources, the foremost being the family in which we grow up. Values are imbibed by observational learning in the early years of life called as imprint stage.

Thus, parents play a very important role as they are child's first "value models". Parents have to be conscious of how they are behaving when children are around. If parents are caring and nurturing towards other people, pets and animals, guests and visitors, elderly, helpers in the house, children will pick up

similar behaviour and act kindly towards others. They will eventually grow up with the belief that "others should always be treated kindly". This becomes an important value for them and they try to practice it after. They not only prefer to be kind to other human beings, but they also do not like when others show harsh and rude behaviour. This will again depend on their own "values". Do they have the value of "courage"? If yes, inspite of the risk of being put down or confronted they will act on this value of courage and rescue the victims. Besides parents, teachers, peers and other people in the environment, culture, media also play a significant role in Value Modelling.

Thus, it is a joint responsibility of the entire ecosystem to decide what kind of generations we want to raise? Partaking of this responsibility we at HEMA Foundation are contributing to the field of Value Education with the aim of bringing values to every child. "4th Chapter - Clause 28 - Students will be taught at a young age the importance of "doing what's right and will be given a logical framework for making ethical decisions. In later years, this would then be expanded along themes of cheating, violence, plagiarism, littering, tolerance, equality, empathy, etc., with a view to enabling children to embrace moral/ethical values in conducting one's life, formulate a position/argument about an ethical issue from multiple perspectives, and use ethical practices in all work."

RECENT PAST EVENTS VALUE EDUCATORS IN THE MAKING




